

It is stated that a number of Abolitionists residing at Salem, Iowa, recently stole 9 negroes from a Mr. Daggs, of Clarke county, Mo., they were pursued and captured by the owner and some of his friends, who, on their way back were, in turn, mobbed by superior numbers of Abolitionists, and their slaves again set free. Subsequently, about one hundred men, all armed, started from Farming-

ton, Missouri, for Salem, Iowa, to recapture the negroes, or arrest the abolitionists.
