Doyle's Trial and Conviction.

Doyle was put upon trial yesterday morning. A jury was obtained with but little or no difficulty.— After the examination of a number of witnesses the counsel for the Commonwealth withdrew all the indictments but one, and the case was submitted to the jury without argument. After a few moments consultation, the jury returned into Court with a verdict of *guilty*, and fixed the period of servitude in the Penitentiary at **TWENTY YEARS.**
