A STAMPEDE. — The "Underground Railroad would seem to be in excellent order. A company of twenty-nine slaves from Kentucky reached here on Monday-evening last, and were safely conveyed to the Canada side next morning. They were all hale young men and women, none of them over thirty-five years of age, for whose re-capture, we hear, liberal offers are proclaimed. They travelled by wagons through Indiana, and reached here in good condition. They preferred to be their own property, and they deserved to be. — *Detroit Christian Herald.*
