HABBISBURG, April 23. It is reported that an aitack was made by Marylanders on Hanover Village, York county, on Tuesday last, occasioned by a great stampede of negroes. Reliable accounts say that whole families are crossing into Adams, York, and Franklin counties in this State. A report places the total loss of slaves by Maryland since the troubles began at five hundred. Great fears are entertained in the border counties of Maryland of the departure of the entire slave population.
