

Harrisburg, 26.—It is reported that an attack was made by Marylanders on Hanover village, York Co., on Tuesday—occasioned by great stampede of negroes. Reliable accounts say that whole families are crossing into this State. Report places the total loss of slaves by Maryland since troubles began, at 500.—Great fears are entertained in the border counties of Md. of the departure of the entire slave population.
