Stampeds of Negroes.

There was a stampede of negroes, 14 in number, men, women and children, in the neighborhood of Lewinsville to-day. They came to our lines seeking protection, easing they were to have been cent to Managas the morning. Gen Smith sent them to Washington. They belonged to the estate of the late Commodore Jones. They stated that they lett at their home only a daughter of the Commodore, her mother having departed some time ago for Managas Janction.
