They therefore quietly abolished hemselves into Illinois, leaving their disconblate proprietors to the sad reflection that ad Congress and the Legislature done their oty, several hunreds of dollars would have nared to their use and benefit where 'nary ed' now represent the value of their dearted fellow citizens."
