## Slave Stampedo in Maryland.

WASHINGTON, June 16.—On Sunday night some slaves in the neighborhood of Annopolis, stampeded taking horses and wagons. They traveled all night, and were reinforced till they numbered 72. Yesterday morning they were met by armcd patrolmen, who endeavored to stop them, firing upon them when about a mile from Fort Meigs. One of the slaves fired in return. The fugitives then separated and fied. So far as known two males and one female slave were killed, and five wounded. The remainder reached Washington.
